

11.00-12.30	Sightseeing Malbork Castle One of the world's most spectacular castles that have withstood the passage of time. If you have never seen Malbork, you know nothing about what a real medieval fortress looks like. It's the largest castle in the world by surface area, and the largest brick building in Europe.

15.30-16.30	Sightseeing Kwidzyn Castle and Cathedral The Castle Museum is located in the gothic Kwidzyn Castle of the Pomezański chapter from the 14 th Century. The museum exhibitions are divided into several sections: historic, weaponry and nature, ethnographic and artistic craft. Excavation works in the cathedral vaults revealed the tombs of	







three Grand Masters of the Order of the Brothers of the German House of Saint Mary in Jerusalem, unique on a world scale.



16.30-17.00 Transfer to Gniew

17.00-18.00 Visit at Gniew Castle

The Teutonic stronghold overlooking the town is the grandest fortress of the Order on the left side of the Vistula. You can encounter the ghost of a mediaeval knight here and come into contact with vibrant, living history of the place. It hosts various performances and knights' tournaments, as well as historic stagings, of which Vivat Vasa is the most famous. The battle staging depicts the clash of Zygmunt III Vasa and Gustav II Adolf during the Prussian War.
